1. Conflict in Code

Existing Code §30-6-6.7 - "Establish inspection requirements for funeral establishments and crematories, including an inspection of a new facility and **annual** inspections of existing facilities"

New Code §30-6-16 (e) "The board is authorized to set fees for inspections: Provided, that there shall be no fee for a **biennial** inspection, based on the funeral establishment's renewal date."

Also in Code

§30-6-3(h) states "Crematory" means a licensed place of business where a deceased human body is reduced to ashes and bone fragments and includes a crematory that **stands alone** or is part of or associated with a funeral establishment.
